*Human Security Committee 2022*

**The Human Security Committee is a student-led programme committee that is responsible for academic events, social events and programme outreach. The committee meets monthly with the programme coordinator to discuss events and future developments.**

## **Academic Committee**

The Academic group would like to focus its work around cross-disciplinary *collaboration and partnerships*. They should be both at a local and global level, to increase the program's impact and create a professional network, while also including diverse perspectives. Events can include workshops, film screenings, guest lectures, peer lectures, panel debate (e.g. inviting previous Human Security students, students who operate within the same field, and those who have experience with fieldwork etc.), career events and networking events. Furthermore, events can be both in-person or virtual. The subcommittee will plan events that address current and relevant themes to our studies. We aim to create opportunities that allow us to apply our theoretical knowledge from classes in a real-world context both for the Human Security programme participants and the surrounding programmes at Aarhus University. By being involved and collaborating with external stakeholders, our goal is to foster involvement, motivation, learning, and co-creation.

All events should be documented so that following cohorts may have a basis for future projects.

## **Social Committee**

The Social Committee aims to create a balance between academic and social life at the university and to provide opportunities for students to interact with each other and build relationships outside of the classroom. We will organize a variety of events throughout the year, including but not limited to: movie nights, beach parties, bonfires, game nights and themed parties. We want everyone to feel like they belong, and that they can have fun and make friends.

## **UN Delegates**

The UN delegates from the UN Council (Uddannelsesnævn) are intended to ensure the academic basis and the educational environment at Moesgaard Campus and at Aarhus University. The UN provides a space, where the members can disseminate information from the students of the Human Security programme and the UN Council. The UN delegates will

represent the Human Security programme once every month during meetings with the UN Council.

### **Outreach Committee**

The outreach committee is responsible for increasing awareness of the Human Security programme through social media, recruiting a diverse cohort through outreach to other universities, and maintaining alumni relations. The aim is to increase awareness of the programme internationally to both students and potential employers. Beyond creating a platform for others to learn about the Human Security programme, we would like to make the program more accessible to those who may not have the resources necessary to apply or attend the programme.
